Stage 5 Agricultural Technology: Plant nursery production

Budding

Materials:

Grafting knife
Grafting tape

Suitable rootstock plants


Suitable scion material (if no suitable material is available, a bud can be grafted back onto the same species to practice the skill)

Methods:

- 1. On a clean part of the lower part of the rootstock make a T-shaped cut.
- 2. With the back of the knife, open the two flaps of the T-shaped cut. See figure 1.




3. Cut a bud from the piece of rootstock, which includes a small shield of wood under the bud. Do not touch the cut surface. See figure 2.



4. Slip the bud into the open T-shaped cut. See figure 3.

- 5. Trim the top of the bud shield to the same level as the T-shaped cut.
- 6. Bind the bud firmly with grafting tape. See figure 4.
