The structure of WorkCover NSW

The Board of WorkCover NSW comprises the General Manager and six parttime directors, which manages WorkCover NSW. The Board determines WorkCover's administrative policies, while the General Manager manages and controls the authority's affairs in accordance with these policies.

The government sets the average WorkCover premium annually on the advice of the WorkCover Board, which takes its advice from consulting actuaries. The Authority's recommendation is based on the annual estimate of liabilities.
